I. What We Need to Surrender

Genuine experience with the presence of God (v.1)

Genuine awareness of our sinfulness (v.6)

Genuine understanding of God's grace (v.7)

II. One Greater Than Isaiah Sent

Jesus was sent to 'die for our sins so we could be reconciled to God.'

"And we have seen and testify that the Father sent the Son as the Savior of the world." 1 John 4:14

"For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me." John 6:38

“for the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost.” Luke 19:10

“Jesus said to them, “My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me, and to finish His work.” John 4:34

“In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins.”

1 John 4:10

III. The Great One Sends Us

“And Jesus came and said to them, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.” Matthew 28:18-20
